WHAT TO EXPECT...

Water training is one of the toughest challenges faced by competitors in the field. It's not just the training challenges presented when you transition your dog from land drills and marks to water drills and marks, but also the challenges you face in finding "good" water on which to train. Gamekeepers will be using the fabulous technical ponds at The Retriever Academy for two days of intense water training.



This Water Workshop is designed for dogs and handlers working at the Transition to Advanced level. It will teach your dog different concepts in marking and blind work on the water. Mitch will work with each dog/handler team to help develop with dog's confidence and skills in the water. Water marking drills and marking concepts will be covered, along with water blinds, water handling drills. land/water concepts, water entry concepts, de-cheating, and more. Basic water work will NOT be covered except as needed to correct an iden-

tified hole in foundation work prohibiting progress with other skills.

PLEASE NOTE: DOGS MUST BE AT A SENIOR LEVEL OR ABOVE FOR A WORKING SPOT.

Working Teams will be limited to running TWO (2) dogs throughout the seminar. Please note that only ONE (1) dog may be run per training segment. Auditors are welcome and encouraged.

Mitch is available the day PRIOR to the workshop for one hour private lessons. Cost is \$50.00/hour, payable to Gamekeepers Retrievers. Ltd. Contact Jan Winner to schedule.

Friday, August 31, 2018 - Privates Lessons by Appointment Saturday, September 1, 2018 - 8:30 am to approximately 5:00 pm Sunday, September 2, 2018 - 8:30 am to approximately 3:30 pm

- Format -

(subject to change as necessary during the workshop)

SATURDAY: Check in will begin at 8:30 am.

9:00 am: Introduction. Discussion of where Working Teams are in training and of their goals for the workshop. Working Teams will run a set up and/or drills designed by Mitch to give him a feel for each Working Teams' abilities.

Saturday will continue as Mitch works with each team based on their needs as submitted on the registration form and based on his finding in the morning session. Water basics will ONLY be covered as needed to remedy an identified hole in the foundation work of a working team. Day will end with Q&A.

SUNDAY: 8:30 am. Discussion of previous day's work. Move to the water where the work will focus on water marking, water marking drills, water entries and exits, factors that influence water work, etc. The workshop will continue on to water blinds, water handing drills, swim by, casting into the water, influence of water marks and blinds on each other, etc. The workshop will end with water set ups for all levels including land/water scenarios. Q&A, discussion and final address will be held at the conclusion of the workshop.

PLEASE NOTE: This is a tentative schedule.

Topics covered each day may be adjusted due to the needs of the working teams, the weather or other factors. Topics listed are representative and not meant to be all inclusive.

From Springfield, MO: Take I-44 west to exit 313 toward OK-10/Miami. Merge onto Industrial Pkwy. Turn right onto OK-10 S/E 100 Rd/3rd Ave SE and continue to follow OK-10 S/E 100 Rd. Turn right onto OK-137 S/S 610 Rd. Turn left onto E 120 Road. The Retriever Academy will be on the right.

From Tulsa, OK: Take I-44 east toward Joplin/Turnpike to exit 302 toward US 59/US 60/ Afton/Fairland/Grove. Continue straight onto US 60 E. Turn left onto OK-137 N. Take first right onto S 625 Rd. Take first right onto E 140 Rd. E 140 Rd. will turn left and become S 630 Rd. Turn right onto E 120 Rd. The Retriever Academy will be on the right.
