This is a hands-on workshop. Limited to 10 dog/handler working teams. Auditors are unlimited. Working Dog/Handler teams will be limited to running TWO (2) dogs throughout the seminar. Please note that only ONE (1) dog may be run per training segment.

A solid foundation of basic retrieving skills is essential for the future success of you and your dog. Mitch will help you to develop a program for you and your dog to build a strong foundation for your dog. Then he will show you how to build on that foundation with the drills and skills needed to take you through to the transition level or beyond.

This workshop will start with a review of all the basic skills. Essential for new dogs and handlers, as well as a great review for those further along, this basic skills review will help you get started or help you identify areas of weakness in your dog's foundation training. Mitch will then focus heavily on drills. Drills are great for dogs of all levels. The drills presented in this workshop will cover basic and transition levels. The workshop will end by covering the transition level skills needed to succeed in at the senior level or beyond.

Mitch has been training retrievers for field work since 1988. A true student of the game, Mitch has developed a program that goes outside the box to enable all breeds of retrievers to succeed at the highest level.
